JULY 8-12, 2019

Notre Dame Vision is a 5-day conference that includes dynamic large group experiences, reflective small group time, profound liturgies, and excellent music. Speakers from all across the country will break open important themes throughout the week and help participants to relate them to their own lives. Sixty-five Notre Dame undergraduates will serve as Mentors, whether as musicians or small group facilitators. Here, 70 highly trained college students will lead you in an exploration of God's call and the ways in which you can respond to this call with your own gifts. You will have a chance to immerse yourself in the spiritually and communally rich environment of the University. You will benefit from some of the best speakers from across campus and across the country whose stories, witness, and humor will challenge you to expand your imagination and deepen your faith. Whether you are in our large group setting as one of 360 teenagers from across the country or in the small group with 7 other teens your own age, you will find yourself in a vibrant and welcoming community that is committed to authentic prayer, good conversations, and real life issues.

Where: Notre Dame Vision is hosted at the University of Notre Dame in northern Indiana.

Who: High school students (incoming 9th graders through outgoing 12th graders) are invited to attend. While on campus, students will be supervised by mentors-in-faith who are trained college students.

When: July 8-12, 2019. Students will arrive in the afternoon on Monday, July 8th and be finished at 1:00pm on July 12th.

Transportation: Our Lady of Grace Life Teen will work with students and parents to carpool to and from Vision. Some years, local parishes collaborate to make a bus available for an additional (but small) fee.

Cost: \$450 for all food, lodging, materials, and supplies, including a \$100 deposit due at time of application.

Cost increases to \$475 per student after **April 6, 2019**.

Our Lady of Grace has a **YM Scholarship Fund** from which students may request funds. That form is attached.

Leaders: Our Lady of Grace may or may not send adult leaders to participate in the simultaneous Notre Dame Vision for Campus and Youth Ministers. Families considering Vision should not assume a leader from OLG will be present for the conference, however, students will still be under the care of adults on the Vision staff.
