From the Deacon's Bench

Brothers and Sisters,

This is a revision/update of my bulletin piece from January 20th. (In that we had very few folks at Mass that Sunday, I wanted to be certain to thank everyone properly, so...)

When we celebrated St. Andrew's feast day back in November, we shared where we, as a parish, were financially. And, as you know, it isn't good. Ody Oruche, our finance commission chair, presented the facts, and we asked for your continued support. And at that time, we announced that we were facing a large budget deficit along with needing to delay some necessary maintenance items. (Yes, without a functioning boiler the parish center has been more than a little chilly these last few weeks...)

With that said, I want to thank you and ask that you please keep up your generous response and support. If you look at the back of the bulletin you will find a running tally of the actual Sunday collection totals compared to the budgeted amount needed each week. When we met in November, we were about \$6900 under what we had budgeted. We are now only about \$1900 under our budgeted amount, and that's with low attendance at Mass on two recent weekends due to bad weather. Thank you! Thank you! Thank you! We still have the overall budget deficit due to the expenses of maintaining an empty school building to deal with, but your generosity has made it easier to keep up with the day-to-day utilities and other bills just to keep things running. We're not out of the woods, but the archdiocese continues to support us. We are continuing (again through your generosity) to carry out our mission and to help those in need. God is good! I'll continue to keep you informed as we go forward.

WE NEED YOU

The Society of St Vincent de Paul offers program to individuals who want to work having a better quality of life. Most people choose to live in poverty but don’t have time or education to plan for a new tomorrow. Mentees of the Changing Lives Forever Program will be developing a plan with specific goals for a better future during the 18- week course. Participants work in groups of 14 and attend a three-hour session once a week.

This year 10 parishes in Indianapolis will be offering a Changing Lives Forever program. This means 140 people will be developing plans to change their lives! Upon graduation, participants are offered the opportunity to have a mentor to help them with their plan. A Mentor can make a difference when change gets really hard. The difference between giving up or moving forward with hope and faith.

We will be needing volunteers who would be a trained Mentor to someone who has graduated. Training involves (2) two-hour classes. Commitment to the graduate is six hours per month (you set the times) for one year.
