

LUKE HOUSE

LUKE HOUSE, part of the Community Meal Program, is located at 310 S. Ingersoll St. on the east side of Madison. It offers meals and hospitality to the poor. Members of our parish have the opportunity to furnish one meal each month. We share our food so that others might eat. We share hospitality and build community when we sit down at table with the guests and eat a meal with them.

This is the menu St. Albert's prepares and serves: Cut-up turkey pieces and gravy served on a large baking powder biscuit, peas and carrots, applesauce, bread and butter, cupcake, milk and coffee.

- We serve our meal on the 4th Tuesday of each month.
- We gather at Luke House as near 5:00pm as possible.
- We warm the food, set the tables, serve the meal.
- We eat with the guests.
- We clean up after the meal and are always finished by 7:30.
- Children are welcome to come with the family, preferably if they are old enough to help.

When you sign your name on the list (posted on the bulletin board in the Narthex), you agree to purchase and prepare, if necessary, that item for that month.

IF YOU SIGN UP FOR:

- TURKEY: Cook a 12-15# turkey, remove from the bone, cut up, and add to canned or homemade gravy. Put it into a covered plastic ice cream bucket (available at the Parish Center). If you prepare it ahead and freeze it at home, please be sure it is thawed before bringing it. Turkeys will be reheated at Luke House.
- PEAS AND CARROTS: Purchase 6 cans of peas AND 6 cans of carrots OR 1-#10 can peas AND 1-#10 can carrots. Vegetables are heated at Luke House.
- APPLESAUCE: Purchase 3-50oz. jars.
- BAKING POWDER BISCUITS: Bake 3 doz. large (4 inch diameter) biscuits. There is no need to cut them in half ahead of time.
- CUPCAKES: Bake and frost 3 doz., any flavor in paper liners
- GRAVY: Purchase 3 regular size cans (approximately 10 oz. each).
- MILK: Purchase 2 gal. 2% milk
- BREAD: Purchase 2 loaves white AND 2 loaves wheat bread.
- BUTTER: Purchase 2 pounds in sticks.

If you plan to go to Luke House to help set up and serve, put a star by your name and bring the food item with you.

You may also choose to bring your food to church when you aren't able to go to Luke House. Most people bring their meal item to church on our serving date. This can be done as early as 7:30 am but no later than 4:00 pm. Others bring it ahead of time. Always label it "LUKE HOUSE" and add the date it will be served.

If you use a container you want returned, please put your name on it, and you can pick it up later from the small kitchen off the Narthex.
