

2019 - 2020 K-8 Tuition and Guidelines

Sacred Heart School is a very important part of the Catholic faith-forming and educational program at Sacred Heart Parish. Over a hundred years ago, our parishioners built the School and they continue to generously contribute their time, talent, and financial resources to its functioning. We are proud of our parishioners and all who actively participate and support our parish school.

While faith-formation and education take place in the classrooms of Sacred Heart School, we recognize that the most important part of faith-formation occurs in the family and parish-community. Weekend liturgies, as well as other activities appropriate to the students' ages and interests, greatly influence their faith development.

Financial resources for the operation of Sacred Heart Catholic School are derived solely from student tuition and a subsidy provided by Sacred Heart Parish.

The approximate cost to educated each student for one year is \$5805.00. Each student's education is subsidized by Sacred Heart Parish. A concern always exists that this system may become inadequate when school families are not active and supportive members of the parish. When families register at Sacred Heart Catholic School, they are committing to being an active presence in community worship, in contributing their time and talents, and in financial support to the parish.

*Registration Fee: \$150.00 if paid by February 1, 2019 at 4pm. The registration fee discount is courtesy of the generous support of Sacred Heart Fundraising.

*Registration Fee: \$260/family Non-Refundable Registration Fee is due at the time of registration.

CATHOLIC PARISH TUITION RATES

To qualify for Catholic Parish Tuition Rates, each family must be an active contributing member at Sacred Heart or another Catholic Parish. A letter of Good Standing must be submitted from your home parish if you belong to a parish other than Sacred Heart.

- The Registration Fee is required at the time of registration. Each child is placed on the class list according to the paid \$250 Registration Fee. If the class list becomes full, then the child will be placed on the wait list. The Registration Fee is Non-Refundable.
- The 1st payment includes a Student fee of \$500 per student. The Student fee is Non-Refundable. This is not an additional fee, but included in the cost of tuition.
- Monthly payments will vary depending on when a family registers.
- The Legacy Fund Raffle (held in spring) is Sacred Heart School's major fundraiser of the year. The goal of this fundraiser is to help keep our tuition costs down, while continuing to provide a quality education to every student. Each family is required to sell 20 raffle tickets for the Legacy Fund Raffle or pay the amount of \$200.00.
- The FACTS Tuition Management Program will be used by all families to pay all tuition fees.
