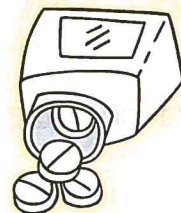

WHAT WE DO

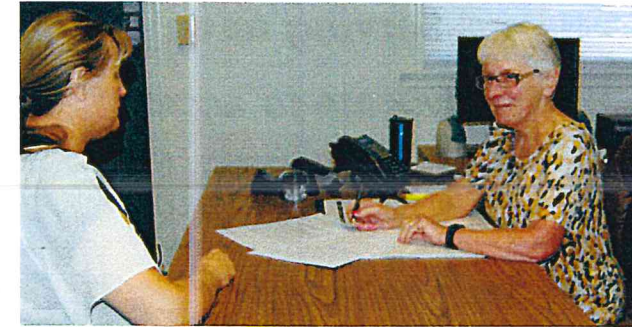

Our prescription advocate may assist with coordinating information required from physicians and their clients. Prescription Assistant may also research medications to determine manufacturers' programs and requirements for assistance.

Assistance with completing and filing applications may also be provided.
