

In this Sunday's Gospel, Jesus promises that at the end of time, everyone who has followed him in prayer, words and action, will be bodily resurrected. The signs that Jesus uses are not meant to scare us, but to reassure us that at the Second Coming, the earth will be re-created to be fully in God's design where neither time nor space will make sense. The earth will live by Kairos: God's Time.

- What is your vision of how the Second Coming will look and sound?
