What is the Reading Support program?

The Reading program is for those learners who demonstrate difficulty in reading, may not be reading on grade level and who need extra support to develop their reading skills so they can function effectively in the regular classroom and serves students as need is demonstrated.

The Reading Support program encompasses the essential components of reading and the Reading Support Teacher works closely with the classroom teacher to ensure progress in reading.

Placement:

- ❖ A score in the 49th percentile or below on two consecutive Reading MAP tests
- ❖ A CSI score of 84 or below
- ❖ Documented evidence of consistent below grade level performance
- ❖ Teacher recommendation
- ❖ Parent recommendation
