It is a long-standing tradition for Catholic parishes to honor the Blessed Mother by crowning her statue in the month of May. The May Crowning ceremony usually includes a procession of First Communicants and other children presenting flowers to Our Lady.

on **Monday, May 2.**



All children in the parish are invited and encouraged to participate in the procession.

Refreshments will be served in the Father Fisher Hall after Mass.

There will be opportunity to make rosaries after Mass, as well.

If you would like to be part of the May Crowning procession, **please arrive at church no later than 6:45pm on Monday, May 2, dressed in your Sunday best.** First Communicants should wear First Communion attire. Children will line up in the vestibule, process in with the group, and then sit with their families for Mass.
