- Y003 **Photographer for Parish Events** – Take photos of parish events for parish scrapbook, as needed.
- Y004 **Stewards of Creation** – Help with recycling efforts.

- Y101 **Hospitality after Masses** – Welcome parishioners and serve refreshments after assigned Mass.
- Y102 **Greeters** – Welcome parishioners before assigned Mass.
- Y103 **Instrumentalist** – Accompany choir and/or cantor
- Y104 **Pianist** – Accompany choir/cantor, an ongoing commitment
- Y105 **Art & Environment Team** – Assist team with creating appropriate Art & Environment for our worship space dictated by Church season. Areas of interest are: artist, banner maker and/or decorator.
- Y106 **Altar Server** – Assist the priest in providing a reverent and enjoyable liturgy for the congregation.
- Y107 **Youth Choir** – Grades 3-12. Sing at one Mass per month during the school year. Practice one evening each week.

## Faith Formation

- \_\_\_Y201 **Youth Ministry Committee Member** – Plan and organize events for youth to share their gifts and talents relating to spiritual growth. This committee has not yet been formed.
- \_\_\_Y202 **Help with Metro Intergenerational events** – Hosted twice yearly
- \_\_\_Y203 **Children’s Liturgy of the Word Assistant** – Help catechists teach children 4 yrs. through 4th grade at 10:30 Mass.
- \_\_\_Y204 **Vacation Bible School Assistant** – Assist and facilitate activities on second week of July.

## Social Justice

- \_\_\_Y301 **Children of the Dump Boxes** – Assemble the boxes, sort & load items and boxes.
- \_\_\_Y302 **Advent Giving Tree** – Assist committee in sorting donations for needy families. Help load up cars and deliver.
- \_\_\_Y303 **Catholic Worker House Meal** – Work with a group to serve a meal.
- \_\_\_Y304 **Community Meal** – Help prepare/serve community meal 4th Tuesday of the month at Queen of Peace Scanlon Hall.

## Parish Community Life

- \_\_\_Y401 **Event Assistance** – Help event organizer in a particular task of an event, as needed, such as: decorating, set-up/take-down, childcare, cooking or serving.

# Additional Opportunities for High School Youth

## Administration, Services & Facilities

\_\_\_HS001 **Pastoral Council (Appointed)** – Provide leadership, direction and policy for parish. Attend monthly meetings.

## Liturgy

\_\_\_HS101 **Committee Member** – Focus on all aspects of preparing for Mass and celebration of the sacraments, monthly meetings.

\_\_\_HS102 **Usher** – Greet those attending liturgy, collect offerings, and distribute bulletins at assigned Mass, usually once a month.

\_\_\_HS103 **Lector (Eligible upon confirmation)** – Prepare and proclaim Scriptures during assigned Mass, usually once a month.

\_\_\_HS104 **Commentator** – Open service with reading and announcements at assigned Mass, usually once a month.

\_\_\_HS105 **Eucharistic Minister (Eligible upon confirmation)** – Serve communion at assigned Mass, usually once a month.

\_\_\_HS106 **Cantor/Song Leader** – Lead congregation in song during assigned Mass, usually once a month.

## Faith Formation

\_\_\_HS201 **Middle School Youth Ministry** – Help plan and facilitate activities for middle school youth during scheduled times throughout the school year. This committee has not yet been formed.

\_\_\_HS202 **Middle School Youth Event Planning Team** – Help local youth ministers plan the Metro Middle School Youth Rally.

\_\_\_HS203 **High School Youth Ministry Praise & Worship Band** – Sing, play an instrument or help with technical details.

## Social Justice

\_\_\_HS301 **Committee Member** – Offer charitable outreach and social justice-related opportunities through projects and related organizations. Attend monthly meetings.

## Parish Community Life

\_\_\_HS401 **Committee Member** – Plan parish community social events. Attend monthly meetings.

## Stewardship

\_\_\_HS501 **Committee Member** – Develop stewardship opportunities for parish. Attend monthly meetings on 2<sup>nd</sup> Monday evening.
